Thank you for your interest in the California Youth Symphony Association's Merit Award in Musicianship and Performance. If you are a member of the Senior Orchestra, Associate Orchestra, or Wind Symphony – or plan to audition for these groups and are admitted – and play a difficult to find instrument as defined by the Music Director or the Wind Symphony Director, you are eligible to apply. Awards will be given in the form of tuition (and/or tour discounts for Senior Orchestra) in order to recognize exceptionally gifted and committed players who play hard to find instruments, and who are seeking to further develop their skills playing these instruments. Please be aware that if you have qualified for financial aid in the form of tuition assistance, then CYS is not able to provide you any additional discounts this year; however, you will be recognized if you receive an award.

Completed applications must be submitted by June 30 of each year*. Announcements of the awards will be made by July 31.

*Applications after the deadline will be considered depending on the availability of the funds.

To apply:

- 1. Complete the application and be sure it is signed by both the student and parent.
- Be sure you have completed the registration forms for the Senior Orchestra, Associate Orchestra, or Wind Symphony.
- 3. An audition video is required as is the completion of all questions on page 2 of this application.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
