# SENIOR ORCHESTRA FINAL CONCERT



Our season finale is an event that you don't want to miss, as we proudly feature the West Coast premiere of Mason Bates' *Resurrexit*, an incredibly exciting and deeply moving work that evokes the dusty mystery of the Middle East with exotic modes and sonorities.

CYS is delighted to offer three senior soloist competition winners this year: Principal Flautist **Diana McGrory** will play the ultra-virtuosic Fantasie Brillante on Themes from Bizet's Carmen, composed by François Borne in 1880, and SO violinist **April Zhang** will perform the first movement

of Shostakovich's haunting Violin Concerto no. 1. Esther Luan will complete our trilogy of concertos with the energetic and propulsive first movement of Khachaturian's Violin Concerto. We close our season with one of the most beloved of orchestral masterpieces, the Suite from Der Rosenkavalier by Richard Strauss. You will be spirited away to the last years of the Habsburg Empire as the orchestra delights you with waltzes and music from what is Strauss's greatest operatic triumph, first performed in 1911 to universal acclaim. Don't miss this exciting and extremely virtuosic final concert!

# CALIFORNIA YOUTH SYMPHONY SOLOIST SPOTLIGHT



### **DIANA McGRORY** | Flute

**Diana McGrory** began playing flute at age 6 and currently studies with Jill Heinke. Diana has performed in masterclasses and has also won awards in local and state competitions as a soloist and with chamber groups. She also loves to teach music and has been teaching flute for 6 years. She co-founded the Menlo Music Mentors program, in which middle school students receive instruction and mentoring from high school students. As the program's co-director, Diana taught group sessions for over 50 students and mentored the other instructors in the program.

### **APRIL ZHANG** | Violin

**April Zhang,** 17, started playing violin at age 3 with Xiaoli Chen and currently studies with Pat Burnham. This is her second year in CYS and in the Senior Orchestra. She has performed in the 2020 California All-State Symphony Orchestra and the 2019 MTAC Convention Honors Orchestra, and she is also a volunteer violin tutor with the Do Re Mi Project. At The Harker School, April is associate concertmaster of the orchestra and is a member of the Tri-M Music Honor Society. Outside of music, she enjoys doing art and design.



### **ESTHER LUAN** | Violin

**Esther Luan** is a senior at Saratoga High School currently studying under Dr. Pasha Sabouri. She began learning violin at age 7 and has won top prizes at competitions including the VOCE Competition and the Peninsula Symphony Young Musicians Competition. Esther has been a member of CYS for 8 years and the Senior Orchestra for 5 years. Outside of music, she enjoys volunteering in local government, dance, and creative writing.

### **APPLE GAO** | Percussion

**Apple Gao** is a 14 year old percussionist and currently goes to Lynbrook High School in San Jose. They have been learning and playing percussion since the age of 5. Apple started off with a percussion ensemble and drum set lessons with Ja Hsieh and started focusing on the marimba at the age of 10. Even though Apple mainly focused on marimba, they still enjoyed playing drum set for the jazz band in school. They also take snare drum and timpani lessons with Artie Storch and learn piano with Shu-Hua Cheng.





### **EVELYN WANG | Flute**

**Evelyn Wang,** 15, has been part of CYS for 4 years and is a winner of the CYS Associate Orchestra Concerto Competition. She started playing flute at the age of 8 and is currently studying with Grace Lai. She won first place at the United States International Music Competition Young Artist Award as well as the USIMC Chinese Music Award. She also won first place in the Romantic Advanced Flute Category for the San Francisco International Innovative Music Competition. Last summer, she debuted Ke-Chia Chen's piece, Kite Flying, commissioned by USIMC. She also took 4 years of percussion with UMusic. Evelyn is in 10th grade and attends Prospect High School. Besides playing flute, she enjoys theatre, both onstage and backstage, reading, baking, and spending time with friends and family.



# SEASON FINALE - Associate Orchestra and String Ensembles

Maestros Eylar and Kyme close the CYS String Ensembles and CYS Associate Orchestra Seasons with a program guaranteed to please and dazzle listeners. Maestra Kati Kyme will direct the Junior and Intermediate String Ensembles, with musicians ranging in age from 7-16, in exciting performances from Vivaldi, Holst, Borodin, Haydn, and others. The Associate Orchestra will feature **Evelyn Wang**, our flute soloist winner of the Associate Orchestra Concerto Contest, who will perform Cécile Chaminade's evocative and impressionistic *Concertino* for flute and orchestra. Also on the spotlight is concerto competition winner **Apple Gao** performing the rarely heard *Russian Marimba Concerto* by Sergei Golovko, a tour-de-force of virtuoso writing for both soloist and orchestra. The orchestra will close the season with selections from Prokofiev's masterpiece ballet *Romeo and Juliet*, the ever-popular

Danzon No. 2 by Arturo Márquez, and Mussorgsky's Night on Bald Mountain.

The June Concert Series continues with a wide-ranging and eclectic program from our wind ensembles. Under the baton of Rosita Amador, the Introductory Winds and Wind Ensemble will delight audiences with pieces from Gershwin, Mozart, and Sousa! CYS is proud to be bringing American optimism and hope at this current moment in history. Along with Maestro Eylar's exciting program of Gershwin, Berlioz, and Strauss, we will be presenting one of the 20th century's monumental works, *The Age of Anxiety* by Leonard Bernstein (who was the son of two Ukrainian Immigrants), with pianist Parker Van Ostrand.
