

Welcome to the 73rd Season!

Join Maestro Eylar as he inaugurates the 73rd season of the California Youth Symphony with a scintillating program featuring the award-winning and internationally recognized Senior Orchestra. Our program opens with *Devil's Radio*, composed by Bay Area superstar composer Mason Bates. Bates holds the distinction of being the second-most performed living composer, as well as being a Grammy award-winning composer and the Musical America Composer of the Year (2018).



CYS welcomes our Young Artist Competition winner Huisun Hong as he joins us to perform what is one of the most beloved cello concertos in the concert repertoire, Dvořák's Cello Concerto in B Minor. Our opening program concludes with a performance of Mussorgsky's *Pictures at an Exhibition*, orchestrated by Maurice Ravel. Originally composed in 1874 as a piano solo work (and one of the most difficult in the pianist's repertoire!), "*Pictures*" has been orchestrated by over twenty composers in the last 150 years. Be prepared for an aural and visual extravaganza as we feature a multimedia presentation of the work complete with a visual accompaniment to the orchestra's performance. You don't want to miss this!

Performs Dvořák's Cello Concerto in B Minor

Huisun Hong, 17, is a senior at Amador Valley High School in Pleasanton, California. He began playing the cello at the age of eight and currently studies under Eric Sung at the San Francisco Conservatory of Music's Pre-College Division. Huisun is the principal cellist of the San Francisco Symphony Youth Orchestra and has been a member since 2021. In 2024, he was the runner-up in the orchestra's concerto competition and had the honor of representing the orchestra at a performance for the donors and sponsors of the Pierre Monteux Society at the San Francisco Towers.

The following Sunday, on December 8th at 1:00 pm (venue to be announced), audiences will delight in performances from the String and Wind Ensembles with almost two hundred 7-17 year olds gracing the stage throughout the afternoon! Directors Kati Kyme and Anthony Lanzino are guiding their talented young musicians through works by Stravinsky, Grainger, Fanny Mendelssohn, and Grieg. Another percussion collaboration by the Chamber Winds and Wind Ensemble sections adds to this varied concert. We hope to see you in the audience this December!

CYS Spain Tour 2024

This past summer, our Senior Orchestra completed a successful 12-day concert tour to Spain, with performances in Segovia, Castellón, Granada, and Puerto de Santa Maria. A highlight was our outdoor performance at the Cathedral of Granada as part of the internationally renowned Granada Festival! Our young musicians performed works such as Stravinsky's *Firebird*, Gershwin's *American in Paris*, living composer Pelka's *Memorias Argentinas*, de Falla's *Three-Cornered Hat*, as well as music by noted Japanese film composer, Joe Hisaishi.

Welcome New Staff




